Faith Formation Volunteer Opportunities

Catechist: You will be the main 'teacher/facilitator' each time you meet. We try to have an assistant in each room. Sunday School meets during the 10:30 Mass about 3 times a month. Children who meet on Tuesday or Wednesday nights (6:15 – 7:30) have a session about 3 times a month. Confirmation teens who meet on Sundays are normally here twice a month this session goes from 7:15 – 8:30 for grades 9 – 10. Catechist training is provided in the fall and winter plus coordinators give you ideas and resources throughout the year. You follow a curriculum. You need to be a practicing Catholic and help bring children/teens closer to Christ.

Substitute Catechist: You 'fill in' for a regular catechist when they need to be away.

Catechist Assistant: Assist the catechist each week with art projects, small group discussion or general activities.

Hall Monitor: Walk the halls, respond to a catechist if they suddenly need something, collecting attendance, etc.

Childcare: Care for children of faith formation volunteers one or two times a month

Onsite Office Helper: Be available to make copies, phone calls, get supplies that are suddenly requested, etc.

Special Projects & Events:

At Home Office Helper: make art project, assemble booklets, etc. at home per request of a coordinator

Learning Center/Retreat Helper: Help set up and/or be available for the Sacramental, Advent and Lent Learning Centers and/or Retreats.

Musician: help lead children in prayer or teach songs

Photographer/Videographer: Be available to take photos or videos of events

Youth Ministry:

Middle School Chaperone: Be present for monthly youth events

High School Chaperone: Be present for various youth events or go on a mission trip

Musician: Lead teens in prayer or youth-type rally

Adult Core Team: Monthly meeting and assist with events

RCIA for Adults, Children and Youth

Breaking Open the Word Facilitator: read and help explain the Sunday scriptures

Sponsor/Companion Family: 'walk' with a child, teen or adult who is journeying to become Catholic

Session Leader: Help present a specific topic and facilitate discussion

Session Assistant: work with the session leader to help engage participants.
